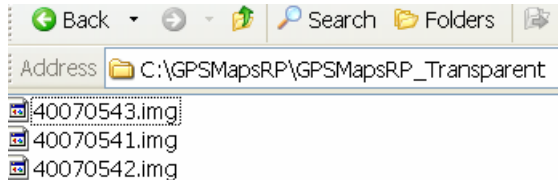


Transp 2A

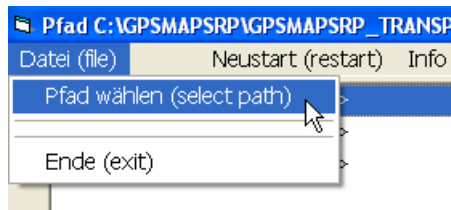
Transp_2A is a batch converter transforming your IMG files from standard IMG (opaque) to transparent IMG and vise-versa.

Steps on Using Transp 2A

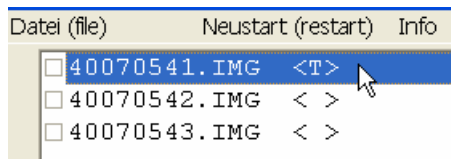
1. Move all IMG's for manipulation to a new folder.



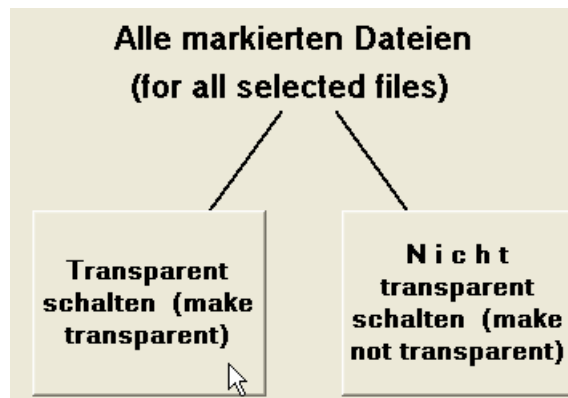
2. Run Transp_2A.exe by double-clicking on the file. Do not put Transp_2A.exe in the folder you created in Step 1.
3. Click "OK" on the instructions that appears.
4. Click on "Datei (file)>Select Path".



5. Browse to the directory you created in Step 1 and select any file. Click on "Open"
6. The list of the IMG files in that directory appears. If you see a "<>" next to the IMG, this means the IMG is opaque. A "<T>" means the IMG is transparent.



7. Select the file(s) you want to convert.
8. Click on the appropriate button; "Transparent schalten (make transparent)" or "Nicht transparent schalten (make not transparent)".



9. If you make a mistake or just want to start over from the beginning, click on the menu "Neustart (restart)".
